Conditions to apply for membership in the New York State Math Honor Society

Students should: Be in grades 10-11

- ❖ Have an un-weighted 85% GPA overall AND have an un-weighted 85% GPA of at least 3 semesters (1.5 years) of high school mathematics courses which give high school credit.
- ❖ Provide above average references from at least two teachers who have taught the student within the last year. **One of these references must be from a mathematics teacher.**
- ❖ Have no other integrity, discipline, or academic issues which would be incompatible with membership in an honor society.
- ❖ Attend monthly membership meetings after school (minimum of 4 meetings per school year), donate a minimum of 5 hours of in-school community service, and complete mandatory 5 hours of peer tutoring through Math Honor Society. Service hours must be completed by May 1st, 2024.
